Curriculum Coverage

English

We will be immersing ourselves in the swashbuckling story: 'The Night Pirates.

We will retell the story focussing on adjectives and ensuring we are using capital letters and full stops.

PSHE

We will be learning all about **personal** and **online safety**:

We will identify simple examples of personal information and who is in my trust club and identify rules that keep up safe when using technology.

Science

We will be learning about the properties of **materials** to help us create a pirate ship that is **waterproof** and **floats on water!**

PE

In PE, we will be learning a pirate dance!

Maths

We will be applying our place value knowledge to numbers to 20.
We will be learning about position, left and right and turns.

Computing

We will be writing algorithms to move beebots around a map linking to our learning about directional vocabulary in Geography.

Music

In music, we will delve into pitch exploration, specifically differentiating between high and low pitches. We will begin to develop our pitch recognition abilities. We will also be composing music through sound effects and storytelling.

RE

We will be learning about Islam and what is important to Muslim families.

DT

We will design and then make our own pirate ships evaluating our choice of materials.
