Curriculum Coverage

English

Our writing focus this term will be on using our **phonics** in our learning, using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces, and forming our letters correctly as we write about people from the past.



PSHE

We will be making a class charter highlighting how we can be the best team we can be. We will think about our goals for this year and what steps we need to take to achieve them. We will begin to identify and name different feelings and how to interpret them through facial expressions.

PE

In PE, we will explore the fundamental skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skip-ping. Develop teamwork skills: earning to take turns, work collaboratively and lead each other.



Wray Common Citizens

This half term, our assemblies will explore the theme of TEAM. Together, we will think about the different teams we belong to – our families, classes, friendship groups, sports teams and, of course, the Wray Common community. We will discover what makes a great team, the qualities of a good team player, and how each of us can make a positive contribution. Through stories, discussions and reflection, we will learn that when we support one another, show kindness, respect and resilience, we can achieve far more together than we ever could alone. As the saying goes, TEAM stands for: Together Everyone Achieves More. Throughout the term, we will challenge ourselves to work together to make Wray Common the very best place to learn, grow and belong.



Art

We will create our own Great Fire of London scene by mixing primary colours to create secondary colours and add a silhouetted skyline of London.



You will:

- ◇ Design and make a Tudor house and create our own Pudding Lane!
- ◇ Learn songs and actions to learn remember facts about the Great Fire of London.
- ◇ Travel through time and discover and learn about inspiring people from the past.



Maths

We will be recapping numbers to 10 with a focus on forming numbers correctly. We will learn about comparing and ordering numbers.

Music

We will learn to use our voices expressively and creatively by speaking chants and rhymes through music from the past.

Computing

We will use a variety of different painting tools on the tablets to create a scene from the past. We will learn about how to stay safe when using a device.

RE

In our Christianity unit this half term, we will find out what Christians may believe about God as the 'Father'. We will focus on the Christian story of Creation from the Old Testament and the responsibility a Christian might feel for caring for the world, and the commandment to 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'
